Achievements

1. Crops

Tomatoes, onion, cabbage, okra, carrots, giant rape, rape, indigenous veggies, moringa, (challenges have been of water). This was grown in the 75m X 70m fenced garden. They sold nurseries to the people in the community

2. A 6m well was dug out and a large stone hindered progress. There is water but inadequate for the garden

CRITICAL NEEDS

1. Water
2. Pig net fence to prevent goats from entering
3. Garden Tools - wheelbarrow
4. Solar charger for phones

3. Loans to Officers

We have postponed the repayments of the loans from the officers but monitoring continues to check progress. One good example is that Bob Dzere and Tariro Mateko make a small surplus in the sales of groceries and buy food items for the two families. Tariro Mateko works with partnerships. The two have also decided to give 10% of the profits to Easter Wirisu the volunteer at Nhaka's Venner garden – buying her small necessities – food items, The Board will meet in this 3rd quarter and take decisions on this matter.
